BOARD OF TRUSTEES LETTER

Thank you to all who contributed to *Bring on The Light* campaign. As of this writing Unity of Desplaines raised approximately \$8,500. This money will be in a restricted fund for building maintenance. The Board along with Brenda Smith will review quotes before commencing the purchase and replacement of lighting ballasts. In the meantime, Brenda has learned that there is a ComEd rebate program to cover most of the cost of ballast replacement with the cost for Unity Des Plaines being approximately only \$500.00! Outside lighting issues are being addressed with quotes for review. The Board is extremely grateful to Brenda Smith for her help with this.

The Board is also continuing to review and refine the process for submitting class/workshop proposals and the process of marketing them so we have unified policies. Megon and the Board have reviewed 3 class/workshop proposals. Please submit written proposals to <u>unitydp@yahoo.com</u> for review.

We have scheduled after Sunday service meetings with the congregation as follows:

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, and diligent focus on expense controls, we have great news of 2024 financial results:

- Revenue was up from the prior year by nearly 20%.
- Expenses were down from the prior year by 16%.
- Net at year end was a positive \$14,924 compared to 2023 which was a \$46,833 loss.

This major turnaround is significant and critical. Instead of dipping into our reserves every month, we are now on the cusp of be-



Why should someone have trouble being who they are? I mean, aren't we all born a certain way —with a particular body and personality and into a certain level of family and social sphere?
